Regularly used terms: JOP - Lottery Funded Junior Olympic Programme at World Class Potential level - the UK's top Juniors. Intermediate Group - divers working towards Grade 4 & 5. Advanced Group - divers that have passed Grade 5. Squads competitive training groups. Novices - first rung of competitive ladder. Intermediate/Age Groups - next rung of competitive ladder. Elite Juniors - highest level domestic event for divers aged 9-18. Junior - 18 & under. Senior - all ages (where you will find our elite Olympic divers).

Diving balcony etiquette - Parents please do not coach your children or call them over during classes, Divers must be clothed and wearing shoes when on the balcony and if you are using still or video cameras, please sign the book at reception and ensure you only take footage of your own child.
